

What to Bring With You on Clinic Day

ALL PATIENTS	
1. Proof of Age	Per NYS: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Driver's license or non-driver ID; ● Birth certificate issued by a state or local government; ● Current U.S passport or valid foreign passport; ● Permanent resident card; ● Certificate of Naturalization or Citizenship; ● Life insurance policy with birthdate; or ● Marriage certificate with birth date.
2. Vaccine Card	If you're getting dose 2 or boosters, bring the PHYSICAL vaccine card OR proof of the series and date of your original doses.
2. Access and promptness	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● <u>Please wear a shirt where we can access your upper arm quickly and easily.</u> ● Do not wear multiple, tight layers of clothing ● Arrive at the clinic location 10-15 minutes before your appointment ● <u>Do not leave your car until 5 minutes before your appointment.</u>
UNINSURED PATIENTS	
Personal ID number	We will need your Driver's License or full Social Security Number. If you have no ID at all, no problem. We will just need you to attest to having no ID or SSN.

INSURED PATIENTS

If you qualify for Medicare, you **MUST** bring your Medicare Card with the **NEW ID** (not your social security number)



OR...

Your Prescription Drug Benefit Card

This will have one or all of the following on it:
RxBIN, RxPCN, RxID, and RxGroup

We DO NOT need your EPIC card

OR...

The Last 4 Digits of Your SSN

PLEASE NOTE:

Tricare beneficiaries must have the SSN of the military enlisted
